

International Sailing Teams in Weymouth and Portland 2011.

This document has been drawn up to allow teams to make the best possible choices in 2011 and to allow one message to be relayed from all of the local stakeholders. This is a different position to previous Olympic Games as the OCOG does not own the sailing site and rents space for the duration of the events only.

Prior to May 31st no containers will be allowed on site (including the land behind WPNSA) unless these belong to teams who have an arrangement with WPNSA. All of these containers will have required planning permission from the local council.

June 1st is the first day of the training period for Skandia Sail for Gold Regatta.

At the completion of SSFGR, all containers must be removed from site unless the team has a long term contract with WPNSA. Please note that team containers that fail to comply with this request may be the subject of planning issues and have challenges in gaining access to their containers – it will also create many challenges for the OCOG in dealing with local stakeholders. At the end of this document we have listed options which a team may want to pursue.

For IFDS competitors, please talk to Chris Knight at WPNSA as he will try to store your boats between the end of SSFGR and the start of the training period of the IFDS World Championship.

IFDS World Championship containers will again be allowed on site, but again due to planning and building restrictions, these will have to be removed at the end of the event.

Prior to the Weymouth and Portland International Regatta (LOCOG Test Event), container arrival on site will be controlled by LOCOG and arrangements must be made via “The Exchange”, the LOCOG system for dealing directly with each Sailing Team Manager. These containers will be placed inside the WPNSA grounds in the same areas as will be used at the Olympics and will be limited in number per team by ISAF policy.

From 24th July 2011, no teams will have access to WPNSA, as construction will be taking place. The Venue will open to athletes at 0900 on Saturday July 30th at 0900 and close at 1500 on Sunday 14th August. During this period accreditation will be required.

August 14th	Site closes	All boats removed from site or packed into containers. LOCOG will remove all containers from the site linking into team shipping contractors

Options

Outside of these dates training and container storage, may be arranged from:

- Castle Cove Sailing Club (container option at Weymouth College)
- Limited container storage at Portland Marina
- Portland Marina can provide berths for ribs and berths and hoists for keelboats
- Containers can also be stored at Southwell Business Park, on Portland
- Quest Marine can offer everything from slipway access and container storage
- In addition there are free slipway and windsurfing access points which may suit some of the smaller classes.
- The above are offers that we are aware of and there may well be additional options for teams to research themselves.
